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BANQUET TERMS

KEY INFORMATION AT A GLANCE

RESERVATION

A reservation becomes binding once it has been confirmed in writing by Elsbethenstübli.

FINAL NUMBER OF GUESTS

The final number of guests must be communicated no later than 7 days before the event. This number forms the basis for billing. Short-notice reductions may be charged.

MENU SELECTION & ALLERGIES

The final menu selection, allergies, intolerances and special requests must be communicated no later than 7 days before the event. If different main courses are selected, we require the exact number of each dish in advance.

CANCELLATION

Up to 14 days: free of charge

13-7 days: 30% of the agreed menu price

6-3 days: 50%

Less than 3 days / no-show: 100%

The most recently confirmed number of guests is used as the basis for calculation.

PRICES & BEVERAGES

All prices are in CHF and include statutory VAT. Beverages are not included unless expressly agreed otherwise.

PAYMENT

The bill is generally payable at the restaurant on the day of the event by cash or card. Different payment terms must be agreed in advance.

FOOD & BEVERAGES BROUGHT IN

Outside food and beverages may only be brought in with prior agreement. A corkage fee may be charged for wines or other beverages brought by guests.

DAMAGES & ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Additional services or exceptional extensions of the event may be charged separately. The organiser is liable, within the limits of the law, for damage caused by guests.

FORCE MAJEURE

If an event cannot take place due to force majeure or circumstances beyond the control of Elsbethenstübli, no liability is accepted for resulting consequential costs.

APPLICABLE LAW & JURISDICTION

Swiss law applies. To the extent legally permissible, the place of jurisdiction is Basel.
