BANQUET TERMS AND CONDITIONS

THE MOST IMPORTANT INFORMATION AT A GLANCE



RESERVATION

A reservation is considered binding once it has been confirmed in writing by us.



FINAL NUMBER OF GUESTS

Please inform us of the final number of guests at least 7 days before the event. This number forms the basis for the invoice. Short-notice reductions may still be charged.



MENU SELECTION & ALLERGIES

Please send us your final menu selection as well as any allergies, intolerances or special requests at least 7 days before the event. If different main courses are chosen, we require the exact number of guests per dish in advance.



CANCELLATION

Up to 14 days before the event:	free of charge
13 – 7 days before the event:	30 % of the agreed menu price
6 – 3 days before the event:	50 %
Less than 3 days / No-show:	100 %

The basis for calculation is the most recently confirmed number of guests.



PRICES & BEVERAGES

All prices are in CHF and include VAT. Beverages are not included, unless expressly agreed otherwise.



PAYMENT

The bill is generally to be settled on the day of the event at the restaurant, in cash or by card. Any other payment terms require a prior agreement.



FOOD & BEVERAGES BROUGHT BY GUESTS

Bringing your own food and beverages is only permitted with our prior approval. For wine or other beverages brought by the guests, a corkage fee may be charged.



DAMAGES & ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Additional services or extended opening hours may be charged separately. The organiser is liable for any damages caused by guests, within the scope of the law.



FORCE MAJEURE

If an event cannot take place due to force majeure or other circumstances beyond our control, no liability is accepted for any resulting costs or damages.



APPLICABLE LAW & PLACE OF JURISDICTION

Swiss law applies. The place of jurisdiction is Basel, insofar as legally permissible.
